2013 has been a wonderful year for PAWM with the completion of the first school. 97 children will start lessons in the school in 2014.

The Ampitagnabo primary school construction was completed in November 2013. A serious delay was the 22nd of February Tropical Cyclone Haruna which hit at the end of February. This caused chaos in South West Madagascar and put everything on hold. Desks will now be supplied by the Education Authorities and teachers are being recruited.
